

Reflection....

The episode of the healing of Bartimaeus in this weekend's gospel (Mark 10: 46-52), has a lot to teach us. We find that the blind Bartimaeus yearns for healing and wholeness, longing to be free from his blindness.

Reflecting on the life of the blind Bartimaeus. we discover that he represents our collective human situation. His story is our story. A story where we constantly yearn for healing and liberation from all the things that hold us down.

Our blindness might not necessarily be the physical loss of vision. However, it could be whatever limits and prevents us from reaching our full potential as human beings. Let us therefore never be afraid to acknowledge our limitations while calling upon the name of the Lord for healing.
